The Benefice of Cowbridge is centred on the old market town of Cowbridge, situated in the beautiful Vale of Glamorgan. The Benefice comprises the town and nine surrounding village communities in a wonderful rural setting. There are excellent schools (primary and Secondary), shops, and social and cultural amenities, and there is easy access to the cities of Cardiff, Swansea and the M4 motorway.

The post provides an exciting opportunity to gain a breadth of experience involving the exercise of priestly pastoral and leadership skills across the three pastoral areas of the Benefice. The Team Vicar will exercise his/her ministry, in partnership with the Rector, Curate, Worship leaders, Eucharistic Ministers, Pastoral visitors and full time administrator. He/she will be expected to make a significant contribution towards, and demonstrate enthusiasm and dynamism for, the growth and development of the worship and work of the whole Parish.

The Team Vicar is of incumbent status and will be responsible for one of the three pastoral areas of ministry. A four-bed roomed house is provided in the village of Aberthin which is very near the town of Cowbridge.
