## **NOTES**

- 1 <u>At least</u> three days notice is required before the first reading of banns: please use the request card you will be given
- If either of you will not be 18 by the proposed date of the wedding, the priest will need to obtain the consent of parents or guardians. Please ask for details now.
- 3. Please see the booklet "Marriage in Mind" which accompanies this form if any of these conditions apply
- This means the Church of England or Church in Wales parish in which you *live, or are* on the *electoral roll.* If either of you live in a different parish from that in which the marriage is to take place, you have to arrange for the banns to be read there too, and obtain a banns certificate. If neither *live* in the parish or are on the *electoral roll*, it may be possible for you to be married in the Parish of Cowbridge by an *Archbishop of Canterbury Special License*. This is not granted when one or both partners have been divorced. Cause must be shown, in the form of a real connection with the parish or church in question; the Special License is not intended to enable parties to choose a church building *on aesthetic or sentimental grounds.
