- *“Those bringing an infant to baptism should give the names of at least one godfather and one godmother to the parish priest. Parents may be godparents for their own child, provided that there is at least one other godparent. Godparents must be baptized Christians, and it is desirable that they should be regular communicants of the Church in Wales or of a Church in communion with it.” (Church in Wales “Services for Christian Initiation”)*
